You must submit a portfolio of 8 – 12 examples of art/design related work that demonstrates your creative talent. The portfolio is expected to include fashion design specific content but can also include works from disciplines such as (but not limited to) drawings, illustrations, fashion garments, fine art, textile designs, object design, graphic design and costume. The portfolio may be submitted via a number of alternative methods that include USB, CD, emailed Zip file, hard copy (Photocopies of original work only - maximum size A3). Your portfolio submission should be clearly marked with your name and contact details. Note that your portfolio will not be returned to you and therefore original work should not be included.

Part D: Design Test and Interview

Based on information provided in Parts A, B and C above, you may be invited to sit a short design test and attend an interview. In the interview, you will be asked to discuss your goals, ambitions, creative inspirations and motivations.
