Entry to the course is by competitive selection.

Stage 1

Make sure you register your interest online in the Cert IV Design (Fabric Design & Print) through the Sydney TAFE site entering all of your details and answering the required questions.

Stage 2

All applicants are required to complete and send to us:

- (a) A creative Portfolio (details below)
- (b) A signed statutory declaration stating that the Fabric Design Portfolio submission is solely your own work. (Attachment A).

Your Creative Design Portfolio and Stat Dec must be submitted together as a complete package.

Please Note:

- I. Every item must have your name, address and phone number clearly on the back of the artwork, as well as on the back of the envelope.
- II. Send the work in a standard A3 sized (not padded) envelope, purchased from any Post Office. **Do not** submit your application in bulky or expensive packaging. **Do not** use plastic envelope or cylinders. Packaging will be discarded before assessment and we cannot take responsibility for storage or return of your folder or packaging.
- III. Your application will be assessed by a panel and a decision made based on the selection criteria outlined elsewhere in this package.
- IV. The design drawing submission must be all your own work. You must sign a formal statutory declaration to this effect.

Fabric Design Portfolio

1. ♦ Three (3) pieces of specified original artwork should document the following topics:

1. Design a t-shirt print for mens or womens streetwear. *Original work.*
2. Design an all-over textile print for home-furnishings based on Geometrics. *Original work.*
3. Design an all-over textile print for clothing based on a floral on the theme. *Original work*

2. ♦ **Six (6) pieces of your own work:**

You may submit any work you feel will communicate your abilities in design. As this work will not be returned to you it is possible to include colour photocopies or photographs of original work. The work should demonstrate your design ability. It is important to emphasise this ability in relation to fabric/fabric design but the work may include design work from other disciplines which demonstrates your versatility.

Please note: You may include artwork that has been generated by digital means (computer) for both parts 1 or 2. However, please ensure that a minimum of five (5) pieces have been drawn/ rendered by hand (this can be a combination of parts 1 & 2).

Format for the work should conform to the guidelines detailed below. Any deviation from this will not be accepted.

- Your artwork should be no larger than A3.
- These pages should be stapled together with your name, email & contact number clearly marked on the back of each page of work.
- DO NOT submit work inside a portfolio case or folder.

IMPORTANT

Your portfolio cannot be returned to you so do not send originals of your artwork.

Entry Criteria to be used by the panel in making their selection will be as follows: For your design drawing portfolio:

1. A creative and innovative approach to design
2. Design/Drawing skills
3. An imaginative use of media
4. Individuality of expression
5. A well-developed sense of design
6. Clean and accurate skills in the presentation of work
7. Adherence to criteria
8. An appreciation of current fashion trends.
